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“ She was one of the best mothers a son and daughter could ask for I'm her son and I'm 24 years old and my mom was my life I loved her with all my heart and I wasn't expecting on her leaving this earth this soon it was a unexpected loss for us. When a person losses his or her mother it one of the worsed things you will ever experience because when you don't have no one to go to your mom will always be by your side. Me and my mom spent alot of time together and mom always had my niece jinger with her and she just turn 2 January 30th. My mom and my sister threw her a wonderful birthday party down at booneville and the recreation center. Jinger loved mom to death, mom went down to my sisters five days a week and babysitted because my sister works at a doctor's office she is a flobottomist. Me, mom , and jinger used to go to Manchester every 1st of the month and go out to eat at McDonald's then we would go to Walmart and jinger would make me push her around on a little pink bicycle she loved doing that. And this pasted Christmas mom bought jinger that bike and she was so excited when she unwrapped that bike Christmas morning. I pushed her around on it all evening outside. While I was pushin her around I looked up at mom and she had a big smile on her face and I loved seeing mom happy i would give anything in this world to have her back here with us. Since she has been gone I have been so lost its like nothing else matters anymore to me. Every night I lay down I cry my eyes out wishing for at least one more time I could kiss her goodnight or have her come in my room another morning a wake me up and say breakfast is ready son get up and come eat with her but I will never hear her voice again and it breaks my heart knowing that. Mom had sugar for about the last twelve years of her life and me or dad one had to give her a shot of insulin three times a day. She couldn't give her own self a shot because she was scared to. The last night mom spent at the house Jackie my sisterhad went to mManchester for something and mom told her to let jinger stay at the house with her while she went up there and she let jinger stay at the house. I came home that night with one of my friends and we worked on his truck most of the night and I walked up to the house about daylight and took a shower and layed down. Well that morning I heard my dad hollering out moms name so I jumped out of the bed and ran in there and dad had picked her up out of the kitchen floor and had her up in the chair trying to wake her up and when I got in there as soon as I put my hands on her face she was so cold so I put her across my shoulders and ran to the car dad was right behind me with jinger I put her in the front seat of her car and I give her CPR the whole way to Manchester hospital. As we were pull in up to to hospital I looked back and a state police was right behind us but dad didn't slow down. As we were pulling up to the front doors of the hospital I jumped out and as I was trying to get mom out of the car that cop had pulled up behind us and he jumped out of his car and was saying something but I wasn't paying no attention to him he was coming around his cop car and j looked up at him and stayed get over here and help me get my mother in the hospital she isn't breathing. He ran over and helped me, when we got her in there it took the doctors twenty five more minutes before they ever got her breathing but she was still unconscious and not responding so they flew her to London hospital in a helicopter were they put two stints in because she had two blocked arteries one behind her heart blocked 100% an another one on her left side blocked 80%. So all of the family stayed out there with her for two days praying for her to wake up or anything but she still hasn't responded the whole time she was there. So after 2 days they sent her to Lexington in a ambulance to central Baptist they hooked her up to a brain monitor

were they found out her brain was constantly having seizures and we found out she was 100% brain dead. After stayin 4 days out there they finally had to
